

Post-Op-Crown- Instructions

Home care instructions for new Crown:

- Congratulations on your new crown!
- You may have had anesthetic today; if so, do not eat or drink until it has worn off. You are numb and could possibly chew or burn your lip, tongue or cheek.
- Once the crown has set for 24 hours, you may eat and drink normally keeping in mind that if the crown is tooth colored, it can break if very hard foods are chewed on it.
- You may return to normal brushing, flossing, and Waterpik use.
- Continue to use the Peridex or Periogard that Dr. Halpern has prescribed for one more week, and then you may substitute Listerine.
